

Arktisk Samarbejdsprogram 2024

Der kom i alt 56 ansøgninger til programmet i 2024, hvilket er 20 ansøgninger flere end i 2023. NRKA valgte at støtte 22 projekter med et samlet beløb på 7.498.954 DKK.
